Clean Water Resources Joins National Council for Public-Private Partnerships

More than \$82 billion was spent in 2005 on water and sewer services and infrastructure, and from 1992 to 2005 total expenditures exceeded \$841 billion.” Unfortunately, until now, the survey reports that municipal experience with existing Asset Management programs has shown that less than 40% of cities experience cost-savings from these programs.
